

# Do I need emergency care?

Do you feel that "life and limb" are in danger?

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent severe vomiting/diarrhea
- Cardiac arrest/stopped breathing
- Severe chest discomfort
- Sudden weakness/slurred speech
- Broken bones
- Deep wounds
- Heavy bleeding
- Severe burns
- Severe allergic reaction with swelling/trouble breathing

- Poisoning/overdose
- Head injury with confusion
- Neck/spine injury with a loss of feeling/movement
- Suicidal thoughts/intentions
- New onset seizures
- Fever over 100.4 in infant under 3 months
- New onset discoloration to lips/skin/fingernails

Call 911 or go to the nearest emergency room immediately and call ahead.
